

The deadline is **September 15, 2010** for submissions for public art work for the **Blaine Lake, Saskatchewan Centennial Monument Project**. The selection committee seeks highly visual sculptural work of high quality and durability. The committee has chosen a stook of wheat to represent its pioneers in celebration of its Centennial. Proposals should include all of the following: a detailed project proposal and statement, including images/sketches/photos to help explain the project visually, a detailed budget to complete the work; artist resume, work examples, list of collections; contact information, e-mail and website (if applicable). Funding available for this sculpture is \$40,000 to \$60,000 including all artist fees, taxes, equipment, quality-approved materials, fabrication, transportation and installation of the work and the base.

The selected artist(s) will be responsible for self-insurance and will provide a budget detailing these and related aspects, including exterior surface protection. Expected completion date: March 30, 2012, with installation of the sculpture May 1, 2012.
