Town Council Election Results

Results of the 2009 Civic Election for Councillor are as follows:

Andy Ciona (162 votes) elected, Bruce Debusschere (68 votes), **Barry Glencross (164 votes) elected**, Lorraine Kouznitsoff - Incumbent (90 votes), **Christina (Kitty) Larson (133 votes) elected**, **Kyle Onishenko – Incumbent (122 votes) elected**, **Lorne Popov – Incumbent (111 votes) elected**, Barbara Woytiuk – Incumbent (63 votes) and **Keith Woytiuk – Incumbent (122 votes) elected**.

Mayor Ernie Crowder was declared elected by acclamation.
