Skating Rink Caretaker

And

Curling Rink Ice Maker/Caretaker Position

(This is one position)

The Duties of this position will include:

- Making and maintaining ice at the Blaine Lake Curling Rink.
- Checking and maintaining operation of the artificial ice plant on a daily basis.
- Cleaning and maintaining of the downstairs lobby and bathrooms, including the furnace area, but excluding the kitchen.
- Vacuum upstairs lounge and wipe off tables weekly or when the lounge is rented.
- Making certain the doors are open for curlers on the nights there is curling activity.
- Ensuring proper snow and ice removal is maintained at the outside entrances to the building, and ensuring fire exit doors on the ice surface open easily
- Ensuring Exit bulbs are in working order and on, over the doors on the ice surface and in the building – in the lobby and the lounge.
- Periodically removing extra snow from curling rink roof.

Other duties as requested by the directors of the BLCA

The Duties of this position will include:

- Maintaining the ice at the Blaine Lake Skating Rink
- Opening & Closing of Facility
- Supervision of Public Skating, Shinny, etc.
- Collecting fees during the above events
- Operation of Concession – chips, bars, etc. – no cooking involved
- Caretaking during hockey tournaments
- Ice Duties – Zamboni operation, maintenance, testing air quality
- Daily Inspections – Ice conditions, Furnace, Boiler Room, Bathrooms, Kitchen, etc.
- Snow Removal in doorways, walkways
- Interior cleaning – floors, washrooms, dressing rooms, spectator and player sections in ice area
- General Maintenance and Repairs
- Other duties as requested by the directors of the BLCA
